We hope to gain your input at this early stage, even before data collection, in planning analyses on economic and social empowerment that would be especially relevant to your work and the work of your institution.

We also note that we expect the data, covering the full sweep of time since 1974, to be made available, with full agreements protecting confidentiality, to researchers in Bangladesh and elsewhere. Data availability is planned within 24 months of completing collection and cleaning.
